Your Housing Future:

California is faced with a housing crisis. The housing marketing has not been able to keep up with the State's strong economic growth and the demand for housing, for-sale and for-rent, is exceeding the supply of homes. Recognizing these trends and the challenges to new development, California introduced the Housing Crisis Act of 2019 (SB 330) to increase development of various of housing types.

With measures like SB 330 increasing California's ability to provide housing, what type of housing do you want to see California provide to meet your preferred lifestyle requirements after you graduate college and over the next 10 years? If you were not able to attain your preferred housing type (due to location, cost, style, amenities, etc.) would you be willing to leave the State? Please provide an essay that discusses the California housing crisis, your future desired housing and how the Housing Crisis Act can be utilized to increase for-rent and for-sale housing. Include at minimum one other novel idea that is not based on current, local policy.
